

SAFEGUARDING

At KSVN, we have policies and procedures in place for safeguarding & protecting everyone. Staff and students are all responsible for safeguarding other (young) people to protect them from harm and abuse.

For safeguarding reasons, all employees, students and visitors to KSVN must be readily identifiable. This means that all other staff and students should be able to identify a person on the premises, usually by comparing their face to the photograph on their KSVN Identity Card. Visitors are provided with ID stickers (name only).

General safeguarding information is available on the KSVN & website & classroom noticeboards, which is updated periodically, including details about British Values and Student Support Services.

Safeguarding concerns can include the following:

- bullying including cyberbullying
- child sexual exploitation (CSE)
- children missing education
- children missing from home or care
- children whose parents are in the criminal justice system
- domestic violence
- drugs
- fabricated or induced illness
- faith abuse
- female genital mutilation (FGM)
- forced marriage
- gangs and youth violence
- gender-based violence/violence against women and girls (VAWG)
- hate
- homelessness
- mental health
- missing children and adults
- peer on peer abuse
- · private fostering
- sexting
